Classroom Updates



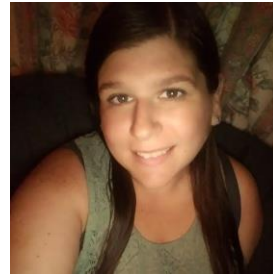
Infants, Pink Room: Ms. Tanisha and Ms. Kaitlin

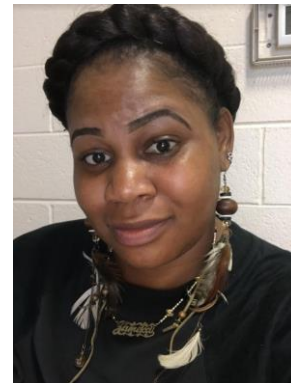
Young Toddlers 18-24 Months, Blue Room: Ms. Chrissy

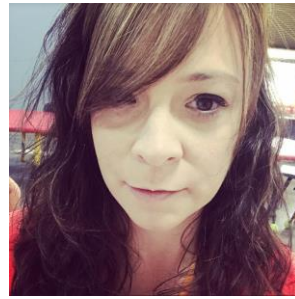
Two's, Red Room: Ms. Brandy

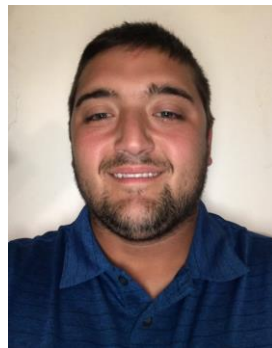


School age: Miss Jay
